Bylaw III. The EFCC Statement of Faith

The essential theological convictions of GBC are vitally connected to the gospel of Jesus Christ, who died and rose again to give us eternal life. Therefore GBC shall adhere to the following Articles of Faith in both their spirit and entirety.

God's gospel originates in and expresses the wondrous perfections of the eternal, triune God

 We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Having limitless knowledge and sovereign power, God has graciously purposed from eternity to redeem a people for Himself and to make all things new for His own glory.

God's gospel is authoritatively revealed in the Scriptures

2. We believe that God has spoken in the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, through the words of human authors. As the verbally inspired Word of God, the Bible is without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for salvation, and the ultimate authority by which every realm of human knowledge and endeavour should be judged. Therefore, it is to be believed in all that it teaches, obeyed in all that it requires, and trusted in all that it promises.

God's gospel alone addresses our deepest need

3. We believe that God created Adam and Eve in His image, but they sinned when tempted by Satan. In union with Adam, human beings are sinners by nature and by choice, alienated from God, and under His wrath. Only through God's saving work in Jesus Christ can we be rescued, reconciled and renewed.

God's gospel is made known supremely in the Person of Jesus Christ

4. We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus—Israel's promised Messiah—was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.

God's gospel is accomplished through the work of Christ

5. We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed His blood on the cross as the perfect, all-sufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.

God's gospel is applied by the power of the Holy Spirit

6. We believe that the Holy Spirit, in all that He does, glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. He convicts the world of its guilt. He regenerates sinners, and in Him they are baptized into union with Christ and adopted as heirs in the family of God. He also indwells, illuminates, guides, equips and empowers believers for Christ-like living and service.

God's gospel is now embodied in the new community called the church

7. We believe that the true church comprises all who have been justified by God's grace through faith alone in Christ alone. They are united by the Holy Spirit in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. The true church is manifest in local churches, whose membership should be composed only of believers. The Lord Jesus mandated two ordinances, baptism and the Lord's Supper, which visibly and tangibly express the gospel. Though they are not the means of salvation, when celebrated by the church in genuine faith, these ordinances confirm and nourish the believer.

God's gospel compels us to Christ-like living and witness to the world

8. We believe that God's justifying grace must not be separated from His sanctifying power and purpose. God commands us to love Him supremely and others sacrificially, and to live out our faith with care for one another, compassion toward the poor and justice for the oppressed. With God's Word, the Spirit's power, and fervent prayer in Christ's name, we are to combat the spiritual forces of evil. In obedience to Christ's commission, we are to make disciples among all people, always bearing witness to the gospel in word and deed.

God's gospel will be brought to fulfillment by the Lord Himself at the end of this age

9. We believe in the personal, bodily and glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ with His holy angels when He will bring His kingdom to fulfillment and exercise His role as Judge of all. This coming of Christ, at a time known only to God, demands constant expectancy and, as our blessed hope, motivates the believer to godly living, sacrificial service and energetic mission.

God's gospel requires a response that has eternal consequences

10. We believe that God commands everyone everywhere to believe the gospel by turning to Him in repentance and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God will raise the dead bodily and judge the world, assigning the unbeliever to condemnation and eternal conscious punishment and the believer to eternal blessedness and joy with the Lord in the new heaven and the new earth, to the praise of His glorious grace. Amen.

Bylaw IV. Additional Articles of Faith

Recognizing the history of GBC as a merger of the Mennonite Church of Vernon and Cornerstone Bible Church that subscribed to a joint statement of faith, the following Articles of Faith shall also be adhered to in both their spirit and entirety.

God's gospel intersects society and culture

1. We believe that the earth is the Lord's and everything in it¹. We believe that God established marriage to be a lifelong commitment between one man and one woman², and that He ordained the family to be the proper environment in which to nurture children³. In His common grace God also establishes governments as His servants for the good order of society⁴, therefore every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities⁵ but, where in conflict with the gospel, believers must obey God rather than mankind⁶ because we are citizens of the kingdom of God⁷. We also believe that Christian liberty will allow for differences in matters of conscience, knowing that each will give account of himself/herself to the Lord⁸. (¹Psalms 89:11; Daniel 4:25; ²Genesis 2:18-24; Matthew 19:4-6; 1Corinthians 7:2-5; ³Proverbs 6:20; Ephesians 6:1-4; ⁴Romans 13:1-7; ⁵Jeremiah 27:5-8; Titus 3:1; ⁶Acts 5:27-29; ⁷1Peter 2:11-21; Philippians 3:17-21; ⁸Romans 14:4-15:7; 1Corinthians 4:4.)

God's gospel encompasses the invisible

2. We believe that angels and demons exist⁹, that Satan is a personal being¹⁰—the father of lies¹¹, the great deceiver, accuser and enemy of God¹²—and is destined to final defeat by the Lord Jesus Christ¹³. Hallelujah! ¹⁴ (⁹Hebrews 1:3-14; Matthew 8:28-33; ¹⁰Matthew 4:3-11; ¹¹John 8:44; ¹²Revelation 12:9-10; ¹³Colossians 2:15; Hebrews 2:14; ¹⁴Revelation 19:1-9)
